### RECAP OF 28 DECEMBER ZOOM MEETING

**Attendance:** 12 **Guest:** Ontario County Administrator Chris DeBolt, Presenter

**Program:** We heard from Ontario County Administrator Chris DeBolt who has been in that position for just over a year. Chris oversees an operation with an \$840 million budget, over 800 employees, and 26 very distinct divisions including the Department of Health, Sheriff's Dept, Meals on Wheels, Highway Dept, Education for children with Special Needs, Real Property Tax Dept. and many others. This past year has presented significant challenges with the Covid pandemic. The County has organized countless vaccination clinics, PPE distributions and, more recently, at-home testing kit distributions where demand swiftly exceeded supply. Efforts are being made with the state to secure more kits so the county can better meet the demand. Chris emphasized that the county is not looking at shutting down school districts as the omicron variant surges. The leadership team meets with superintendent's every week and everything is being done to keep schools open. At least one positive out of the Covid situation has been the new partnership the county has forged with all school districts to deal with this and, potentially, future crises. It was a very informative meeting. We thank Chris for his time and program chair Mary Beer for inviting him to present.
