Recent donations, from individuals, and businesses such as Hallagan Furniture and Lowes, include a new washer and dryer, a new living room set, new stairway carpeting, refrigerator, and all-weather porch furniture (from a Rotary Grant). Volunteers have painted, wall-papered, hung new pictures, and, as an Eagle Scout project, built a patio area with a swing for the good weather. Ron Maslyn Landscaping does spring and fall clean-up and landscaping each year. The two resident rooms have been updated. A big thank you goes out to Jeff Criblear who has done much of the installation work.
