RECAP OF 3 MAY MEETING:

Program: John Mueller brought us up to date on all that is happening with Willow Bend farms, an enterprise founded by his parents, George and MaryLou, in 1957. In 1960 they started dairy farming when the first cow was purchased. Today Willow Bend has 3 Sites, 90 Employees, over 5,000 Cows, and over 9,000 Crop Acres.

Willow Bend is currently milking 1350 cows and raising 2500 young stock. Spring Hope Dairy in Hopewell is milking 1900 cows. Bonna Terra Farm, located in Bloomfield, is currently milking 1550



cows. Much of their milk is sold to the Upstate Farms cooperative, although some is sold to yogurt and cheese manufacturers. It is a very successful operation that reflects the efforts of a hard working, dedicated family. John reports that his dad is doing well and is about to turn 90 and his mom is doing well at 86.
