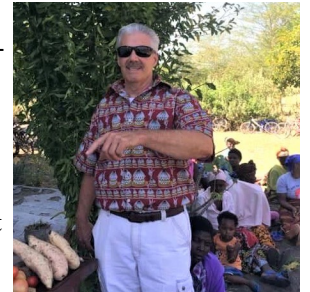


- 2) Our **Changeover** celebration will be held on Wed. June 29 starting time TBA. Further details to be announced.
