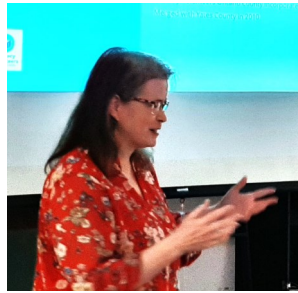
RECAP OF 27 SEPTEMBER MEETING

PROGRAM: Liz Searle told us about the great programs offered by the Literacy Volunteers Ontario – Yates, Inc. (LVOY). Their mission is to provide adults the literacy skills needed to reach their full potential as individuals, parents, workers and citizens. They use highly qualified, committed tutors who are trained in student-centered learning. They provide tutoring that is specifically geared to each student's particular learning style. They set mutual goals that are realistic and attainable. They are in need of volunteers who can contribute talents and experience and reap the reward of bringing the gift of literacy to adult learners in Ontario and Yates County. Sessions take place in public places such as local libraries, including here in Clifton Springs and Phelps, on a schedule that is mutually convenient for the tutor and student. Improved literacy rates not only improve the quality of life for the individual involved but helps improve social and economic conditions in the region serviced.
