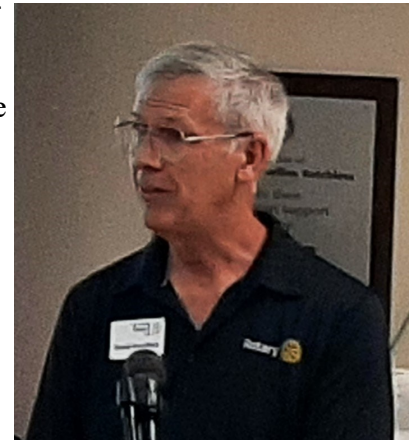
ANNOUNCEMENTS:
