This is not the same as the DMV program. Tracy told us, quite poignantly, of the life-saving and life-changing services this wonderful program offers. It is important to tell your family what your wishes are regarding organ donation. Making your decision now means they won't have to make it on your behalf later, perhaps under difficult circumstances. Enrolling in the NYS Donate Life Registry is the best place to document your wishes regarding donation. However, you can also include the information in a living will or health care proxy. Thank you Tracy for a very meaningful program.
