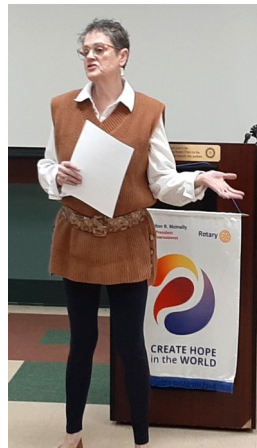
RECAP OF MEETING OF 23 JANUARY

PROGRAM: Becky Sloane, Youth Curriculum Coordinator for the Clifton Springs Library, told us about the extensive plans the

library has for **April 8** of this year. On that date our community will experience a **Total Solar Eclipse** for 2 minutes and 58 seconds. The eclipse will begin at 2:22 pm, totality at 3:22, ending at 4:22. This will not happen again in our village until 2144. This is, then, truly a once in a lifetime experience. Because this is expected to draw many people from outside of our area, the path of totality is quite narrow, the library is planning a myriad of activities at John Brown Park. Besides educational and craft activities there will be music, dancing and dinner. The library will be looking for volunteers to help with, among other things, the ziti dinners, parking and traffic control, making t-shirts, promotion, etc. Rotary will be provided with specific time frames and tasks to be done when the plans are firmed up. 
