**PROGRAM:** Part II of the Membership Workshop.

- 1) We talked about "YOUR ROTARY ELEVATOR PITCH: WHAT TO SAY WHEN SOMEONE ASKS – WHAT IS ROTARY?"
- 2) Speaking from her heart, President Tracy talked about how important Rotary has been to her, and to her family, for many years.
