## RECAP OF 18 JANUARY 2022 MEETING

**Attendance:** 10 **Guest:** Dave Wright, our presenter via Zoom.

**Program:** Victor Hiking Trails (VHT) Chairman Dave Wright, gave a very interesting talk about the non-profit all volunteer organization that builds and maintains hiking and biking trails and paths in Victor, New York. They are open for all to use. Most of these are open to bikes; the major exception is most of Ganondagan State Historic Site. Some trails close for hunting seasons. They work closely with the Town government, Ganondagan, and other civic and volunteer trail groups. Since their beginning in 1991, Victor has created a trail system with over 65 miles – and growing – of trails with connections leading to many hundreds of miles in neighboring trail systems. VHT actively maintains about half of those miles. The VISION of VHT is:



- Create and maintain foot trails and multi-use paths in the Town of Victor.
- Promote a meaningful relationship with nature.
- Promote individual responsibility for protecting the environment.
- Provide recreational activity through walking, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing.
- Provide education to the public through nature interpretation, historical information and proper use of trails.
- Promote good relationships with all people (landowners, government officials, adjacent townships, and trail users).
- Trails for foot traffic and paths for multi-use including bikes.
