RECAP OF MEETING OF 14 FEBRUARY

PROGRAM: Past District Governor Janet Tenreiro brought us up to speed on Rotary's 35+ year promise to the children of the world to eradicate polio. She gave an overview of the history of the program starting in 1979 in the Philippines expanding to the rest of the world in 1985 with the PolioPlus campaign. Since then Rotary's funding for polio eradication has exceeded \$1 billion. Our partners, including the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, UNICEF, the WHO, the CDC and others have contributed significant amounts as well. In 2022 the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation pledged to invest an additional \$1.2 Billion towards wiping out polio. The sum will be donated to the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, a public-private partnership led by national governments that aims to end the disease by 2026. Since its launch in 1988, the GPEI has helped reduce polio cases by more than 99 percent worldwide and prevented more than 20 million cases of paralysis. Pakistan and Afghanistan are the only 2 countries where the wild poliovirus remains endemic, though Malawi and Mozambique detected imported wild polio cases in 2022.
