Lock and Talk is a comprehensive approach to suicide prevention in Ontario County, NY



#### IT IS INTENDED TO:



Prevent suicides by limiting access to firearms, medications and other potentially dangerous items during a mental health



Educate the community about how to recognize and respond to warning signs of suicide.

#### **WE PROVIDE:**

- No cost suicide awareness and prevention trainings
- Safety devices including locking medication boxes and gun locks
- Support material for gun retailers and ranges
- Lethal means safety guidelines
- Educational brochures and informational posters
- Consulting services to schools, workplaces, and organizations to support creating comprehensive suicide prevention policies
