Noah spoke about Connections and how they serve individuals with substance use disorders and their families. It is a comprehensive program that provides multiple pathways to recovery, and helps to bridge an array of community services and formal treatment opportunities.

This holistic recovery program offers support for mind, body and spirit. Services are provided in a welcoming and compassionate environment that promotes healing. Activities include health and wellness classes, education and skill



-building classes, and support groups. Peer support services are delivered by Certified Recovery Peer Advocates (CRPA), who are persons in recovery or affected by addiction who have been trained to utilize their lived experiences to assist others in recovery.
