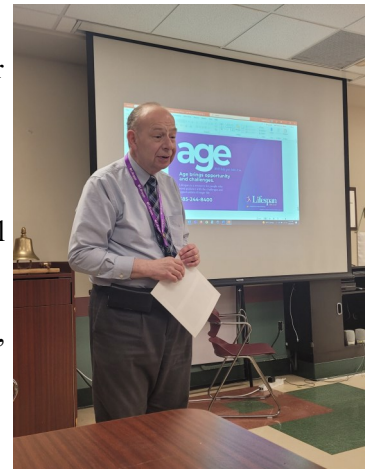
PROGRAM: LIFESPAN
