RECAP OF MEETING OF 2 May

PROGRAM: SCHOOL BUDGET

Karl Dubash, Business Administrator; Superintendent Nick Ganster and Tracy Altman, School Board President presented the 2023-2024 Budget. They spoke on the adopted budget of approximately \$44.47 million for the 2023-2024 school year.

The proposal calls for a 2% tax levy increase, which is well below the District's tax levy limit set by the state.

Voters will also be asked to elect two candidates to three-year terms on the Board of Education, approve a proposition to purchase five new buses, and establish a capital reserve fund to offset future capital improvement projects.

A separate funding measure for the Clifton Springs Library and Phelps Community Memorial Library will also be on the ballot.
