PROGRAM: Danielle Tilden, Executive Vice President of FLACRA, told us about emerging trends in their efforts to provide quality care for individuals and families in the Finger Lakes area whose lives are affected by substance use disorder and/or mental health care needs. Significant challenges have emerged in recent years as a result of the covid pandemic, increasing mental health issues, including suicide among all demographics and age groups, and the impact of wide spread fentanyl contamination and the resulting overdosing. Of particular concern is dealing with the needs of children who have lost one, or both, parents to one, or more, of the aforementioned issues. FLACRA has been going into schools offering "a lot of education" on these topics. Rotarians can help by cutting though the stigma and by being willing to have candid conversations about these topics, by recognizing addiction as an illness



and mental health issue; and by embracing in-coming Rotary president Gordon McInally's focus on mental health.
