PROGRAM: PDG Mark Wyse gave us an update on the "Progress Status" of Camp Onseyawa, as our new site at Camp Whitman prepares to open in less than two weeks. Our club, with the assistance of a District Grant, is supporting the building of two new pavilions. Mark shared the good news that "due to being able to combine delivery for all pavilions to one time delivering and using the Camp Onseyawa tax



exempt status, Doug Fields of Matthews and Fields will be issuing each of the clubs doing grants for the pavilions a check back for roughly \$1,111.58." At least 7, of the 18 or so projects, are completed. The remainder are in process some of which should be completed during the work day scheduled for Sat. Aug. 5. Mark asked us to consider using some of our returned funds to help fund putting crushed stone down for a floor for the pavilions.
