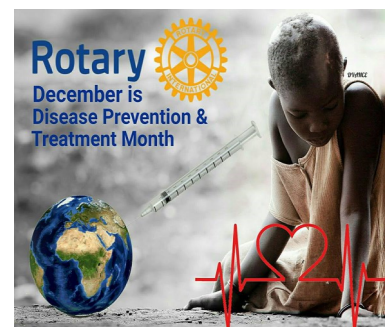
- 1) There will be **no meetings** on December 26 or January 2 because of the holidays.
