### **RECAP OF MEETING OF 30 JANUARY**

**ATTENDANCE:** 12 at the House of John on Spring St. We welcomed Nub Allen back. Nub had back surgery a couple of months ago and has not been able to attend our meetings. He is doing well and is making progress.

**PROGRAM:** Executive Director and Rotarian Kathy Barrick welcomed us to The House of John. Kathy told us about the history, successes, and challenges the House of John has faced over the past 30 years. It is a non-profit 501(c)3 organization. The mission of which is to provide compassionate care, offering sen-



sitivity and support for people as they approach the end of their lives. The idea is to care for the dying in our communities in a comfortable, home-like setting by trained volunteers and staff. It is supported by grants, gifts, fundraisers, and the generosity of many kind and compassionate people from around our area. There is no cost to the residents. Over 800 individuals, and their families, have been served by the House of John. At one time up to 80 volunteers were on staff. Due to aging out, Covid, and other factors volunteers number in the 30's now. Only enough to care for one resident at a time. Kathy indicated if they could get to 50

volunteers they could open a second bed. It is staffed 24/7. Family members are welcome at any time and may even stay in upstairs bedrooms. Volunteers typically work four hour shifts and can determine the days & times they are able to work.
