Why a Fund for Women and Girls is Necessary

The number of families (a family of 4) living below the poverty level (that's \$24,848) in Ontario County has grown from 7% in 2000 to 10% in 2016. In Yates County it has grown to 13%.

Single Parent Head of Households living in poverty in Ontario County have grown from 26% in 2000 to 33% in 2016. In Yates County it has grown from 30% to 33%. It is important to note that most of these households are headed by WOMEN as single parents.

Children suffering from abuse or neglect in Ontario County, in the same time period, has grown from 19% to 23%. In Yates it has grown from 16% to 31%
