- Disconnection from Others Loneliness
- Disconnection from Meaningful Values
- Childhood Trauma
- Disconnection from Status
- · Disconnection from Nature
- Disconnection from a Secure and Hopeful Future
- Genetic Influence (37%)
- · Changes in the Brain
